

What is IB?

Sargeant is an authorized IB World School, offering the IB Primary Years Programme for all of our students without tuition fees or admissions testing. The IB curriculum works to develop the intellectual, emotional and physical potential of each child by focusing on the Three Main Components of PYP:

- · Inquiry-based instruction where teachers develop trans-disciplinary units based on themes that reflect essential knowledge and that encourage students to ask questions and become architects of their own learning.
- . Becoming internationally minded by giving students opportunities to learn about their own culture and the cultures of people from around the globe. This includes weekly Spanish instruction for all students TK - 5th grade.
- . Action by going through the three steps of choosing, acting and then reflecting back upon the results of their choice. This allows students to grow socially and personally, developing skills such as cooperation, problem solving, conflict resolution and critical thinking.

With an IB education, students develop skills and knowledge through inquiry-based learning. This means we strive to instil the critical thinking skills that teach our students how to ask the right questions, cultivating an intellectual curiosity they'll benefit from through all their years of lifelong learning.
